
ELECTRICAL SAFETY RECALL

Panasonic Laptop CF-AX Series, CF-C2 Series and CF-SX Series Battery Pack



IDENTIFICATION:

Panasonic Laptops – Models CF-AX Series, CF-C2 Series and CF-SX Series containing a battery pack. The model number can be found on the front of the Panasonic Laptop as shown. The Laptops were sold in Australia from April 2013 until March 2016.

DEFECT: The Laptop battery pack may overheat due to a software configuration issue.

HAZARD: There is a risk that the Laptop battery pack may overheat and potentially cause a fire hazard.

ACTION REQUIRED:

- 1. Check your Laptop battery pack to determine if there is any excessive heat.
- 2. Use the Battery Pack control utility in the Laptop to configure the battery pack power usage by adjusting the charging control utility to "Eco Mode".
- 3. If your Laptop does not have the Battery Pack charging control utility then follow the instructions on the Panasonic website: <u>http://toughbook-au.panasonic.com.au/battery-safety-notice-ax-c2-sx-series</u> to receive more information.
